**This is Part 2 of the Book Club Adventure Experience. You must complete Book Club Adventure Part 1 before you do this activity. **




Hello again!

A noun names a person, place or thing







(Describing Word)


A word that describes a noun

Tells How, How Often, When and Where




Word Wizard – Word Sketch –
