

Multiplication Facts Fun

Practice your multiplication facts using dice or cards. Have fun!



Dice:

Materials needed: 6 or 10 sided dice

1. Choose a set of facts you would like to work on. For example, maybe you want to work on your 4s facts. You would choose 4 as your first factor.
2. Roll a die and then multiply the number you rolled by 4. Example: if I rolled a 3, I would multiply 4×3 .
3. If you want to make it competitive, play with partner or a group and see who can call out answer first. The person who calls out the correct answer first, gets 2 points. A tie is 1 point. An incorrect answer is a loss of 1 point. Whoever gets to 10 points first, wins the round.



Cards:

Materials needed: A deck of cards with King and Queen cards removed. An Ace is 1 and a Jack is 0.

1. Choose a set of facts you would like to work on. For example, maybe you want to work on your 4s facts. You would choose 4 as your first factor.
2. Pull a card from deck and then multiply the number on the card by 4. Example: if I pulled a 3, I would multiply 4×3 .
3. If you want to make it competitive, play with partner or a group and see who can call out the answer first. The person who calls out the correct answer first, gets 2 points. A tie is 1 point. An incorrect answer is a loss of 1 point. Whoever gets to 10 points first, wins the round.
